# **ORDINANCE NO. 20130228-028**

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CITY CODE SECTION 12-4-64(D) TO ESTABLISH A MAXIMUM SPEED LIMIT OF 55 MILES PER HOUR ON TWO SEGMENTS OF MCKINNEY FALLS PARKWAY.

## BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:

**PART 1.** City Code Section 12-4-64(D) (*Table of Speed Limits*) is amended to add the following:

McKinney Falls Parkway from 3,500 feet south of Shaw Lane to 5,700 feet south of Shaw Lane. (55 mph)

McKinney Falls Parkway from Colton Bluff Springs Road (north segment) to 540 feet south of Colton Bluff Springs Road (south segment). (55 mph)

**PART 3.** The amendments made in this ordinance are based on the results of a traffic engineering investigation, or "speed study," attached as Exhibit "A".

**PART 4.** The amendments made in this ordinance shall be incorporated in alphabetical order and the existing entries reordered accordingly.

PART 5. This ordinance takes effect on March 11, 2013.
