ORDINANCE NO. 20130228-033

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 20130131-028 AUTHORIZING ONLY BIKING ON CERTAIN TRAILS ON A 24-HOUR BASIS FOR THE 2013 CALENDAR YEAR.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:

PART 1. FINDING. Council has allocated \$350,000 for a pilot program for biking on certain trails on a 24-hour period for Fiscal Year 2012-13.

PART 2. Ordinance No. 20130131-028 is amended to read:

Part 2. The ordinance creates a pilot program, [contingent upon Council allocating funding to the program] allowing [walking or] biking [for transportation purposes on a basis of up to] for 24 hours per day for the 2013 calendar year on any or all of the following multi-use trails:

- (A) the Ann and Roy Butler hike and bike trail;
- (B) the Shoal Creek Greenbelt Trail <u>from Lady Bird Lake to 38th Street</u>; and
- (C) the Johnson Creek Greenbelt Trail.

PART 3. City Code Section 8-1-14 (*Use of Parks During Certain Hours Prohibited*) is waived for the limited purpose of [walking or] biking during the pilot program period for the trails specified in Part 2.

PART 3. This ordinance takes effect on March 11, 2013.
