Additional Backup Information						
The purpose of this agreement is to allow students enrolled in the Austin Independent School District's (AISD) LBJ Fire Academy (LBJFA) the ability to ride-out on fire apparatus from either the Kyle Fire Department (KFD) or the Austin Fire Department (AFD) as a part of their Emergency Medical Service experiential learning. By written agreement with AISD, KFD is the Emergency Medical Service Coordinator for the program and they instruct LBJFA students regarding patient contact. KFD has requested the cooperation of AFD in the development and implementation of the fire apparatus ride-out phase of the curricula because AFD sees more activity per shift, thereby giving students more exposure to learning events. All student contact with patients must be under the direct supervision of a system certified provider (KFD or AFD) and all interventions will be in compliance with the Austin Travis County Clinical Operating Guidelines. AFD retains full responsibility for the care of patients and will maintain administrative and professional supervision of students insofar as their presence affects the operation of the facility, the provision of treatment, and/or the care of patients.
