Authorize award and execution of a 36-month requirements service contract with MIDSTATE ENVIRONMENTAL SERVICES, to provide maintenance and repairs for Parts Washer machines for the Fleet Services Department in an estimated amount not to exceed \$163,669, with three 12-month extension options in an estimated amount not to exceed \$77,698 for the first extension option, \$93,237 for the second extension option, and \$111,885 for the third extension option for a total estimated contract amount not to exceed \$446,489.

Amount and Source of Funding

Funding in the amount of \$22,482 is available in the Fiscal Year 2012-2013 Operating Budget of the Fleet Services Department. Funding for the remaining 30 months of the original contract period and extension options is contingent upon available funding in future budgets.

Fiscal Note

There is no unanticipated fiscal impact. A fiscal note is not required.

Additional Backup Information			

This contract will establish a reliable source for preventative maintenance and repair services for parts washing machines used at each of the City's Fleet service centers and one unit for Austin Water Utility.

Additionally, this Contract will include training for service center technicians on the proper care and operation of the machines. Preventative maintenance of the parts washing machines will be performed on a monthly basis and the repair services will be on an as-needed basis.

In order to determine the best-value to the City, evaluation criteria included hourly labor rate for repairs, flat fee for preventative maintenance, flat fee for training, specified replacement parts and material, and local presence.
