**WHEREAS**, the City Council finds it in the best interest of the citizens of the City of Austin to authorize the application for \$628,779 in grant funding from the Texas Automobile Burglary and Theft Prevention Authority to implement the Austin Police Department project entitled APD Auto Burglary and Theft Interdiction Project; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council has considered the proposed application for grant renewal funds for said project in the amount of \$628,779 from the Texas Automobile Burglary and Theft Prevention Authority, to implement the Austin Police Department project entitled APD Auto Burglary and Theft Interdiction Project; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council commits to providing for the applicable matching funds as required; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council designates the Deputy City Manager for Public Safety as the authorized official who has the power to apply for, accept, reject, agree to alter or terminate this grant; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council agrees that in the event of loss or misuse of the APD Auto Burglary and Theft Interdiction Project funds, the funds will be returned to the Texas Automobile Burglary and Theft Prevention Authority in full;

The City Council approves the application for grant funding from the Texas Automobile Burglary and Theft Prevention Authority, for the APD Auto Burglary and Theft Interdiction Project in the amount of \$628,779.
