Authorize award and execution of Amendment No. 1 to various supply and service contracts through the STATE OF TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF INFORMATION RESOURCES cooperative purchasing program for the purchase of computer software and software maintenance and support services to increase the authority for Austin Energy in an estimated amount not to exceed \$120,000, for a revised estimated authorization amount for Austin Energy not to exceed \$9,230,190.

Amount and Source of Funding

Funding in the amount of \$100,000 is available in the Fiscal Year 2012-2013 Capital Budget of Austin Energy.

Funding in the amount of \$20,000 is available in the Fiscal Year 2012-2013 Operating Budget of Austin Energy.
