Authorize award and execution of a 36-month requirements supply agreement with INGRAM LIBRARY SERVICES, INC. for the purchase, cataloging, and processing of adult and juvenile books for the Austin Public Library in an estimated amount not to exceed \$6,451,650, with three 12-month extension options in estimated amounts not to exceed \$2,150,550 per extension option, for a total estimated contract amount not to exceed \$12,903,300.

Amount and Source of Funding

Funding in the amount of \$646,063 is available in the Fiscal Year 2012-2013 Operating Budget of the Library Department. Funding in the amount of \$250,000 is available in the Fiscal Year 2012-2013 Capital Budget of the Library Department. Funding for the remaining 31 months of the original contract period and extension options is contingent upon available funding in future budgets.

This contract is for the purchase of adult and juvenile books and will include cataloging and processing services for the Austin Public Library (APL). The books will be fully cataloged and processed as "shelf ready" for immediate checkout by library card-holders. In addition to cataloging and processing services, APL will have access to the contractor's online ordering system. Some features of the online ordering system include the ability to track orders, provide real-time inventory information, download reports, access to pre-publication announcements, advance notification of upcoming release dates, and other featuers which will aid APL staff in the development and selection of its book collection.

This contract encompasses both hardback and paperback books, including newly published novels and reference books. The Contractor will ship directly to each of the 20 branch libraries, the Central Library, and the Austin History Center.
