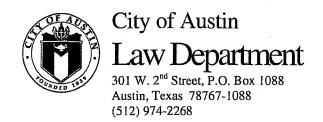

This Engagement Letter confirms that you will represent the City of Austin to provide legal services concerning the above-referenced matter. The City cannot pay invoices from other businesses if they were not hired directly by the City.

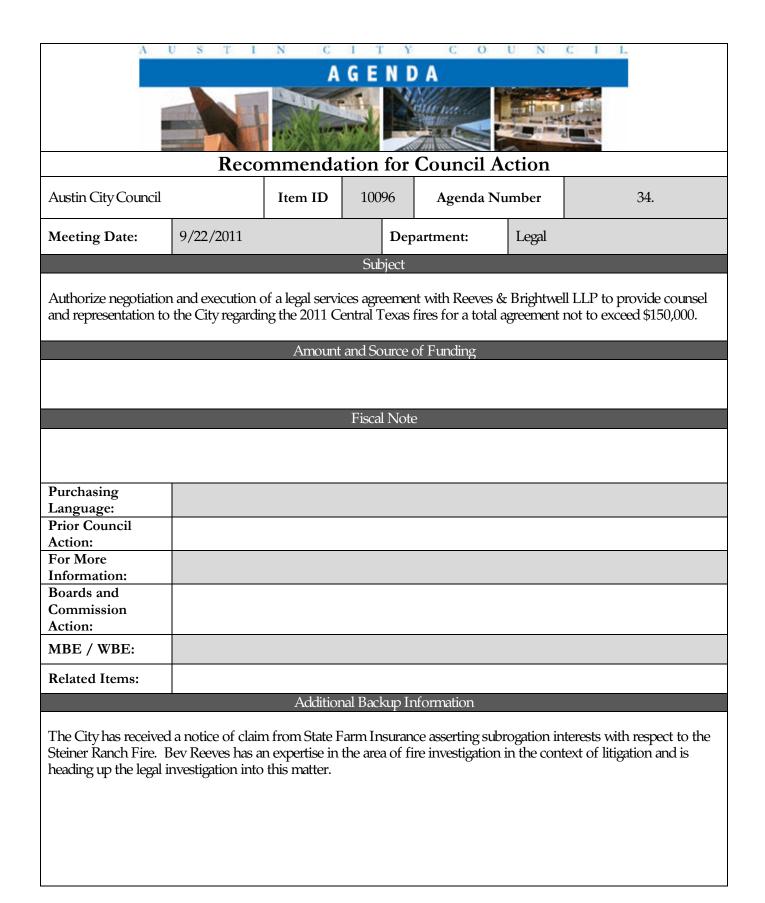
