## *Fractal Tree*

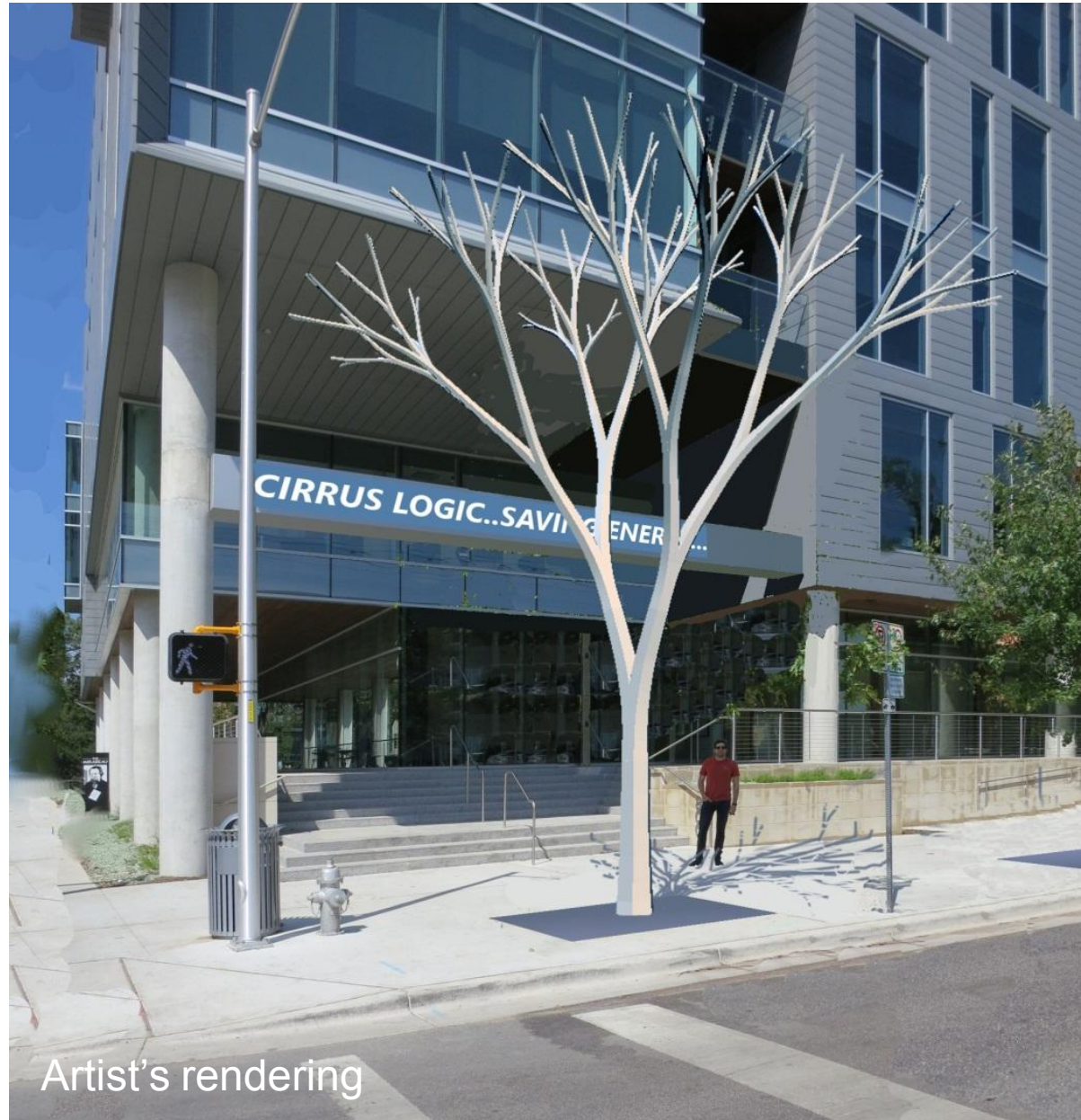
Artist: Paul Sorey

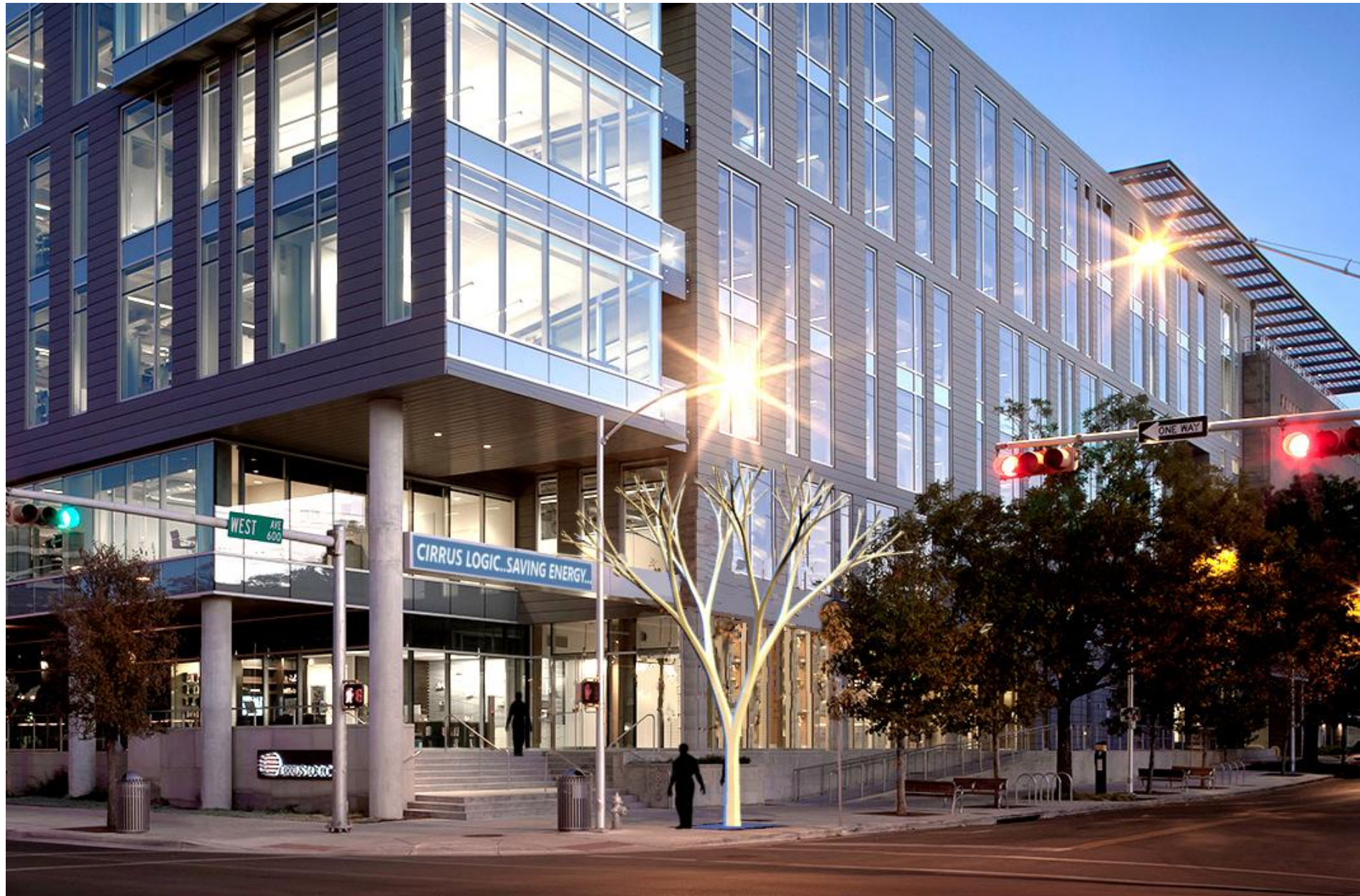
Medium: Stainless steel

Height: 25 feet

Location: 800 W. Sixth St.

The tree is a mathematically generated fractal: each part of the tree is an identical copy of the other parts, scaled and rotated in space.







# Art in Public Places Program

## Donation Review Process

November 2012: Cirrus Logic approaches CoA Great Streets program with donation proposal

December 2012: Art in Public Places program works with Cirrus Logic to complete donation application and facilitates review process

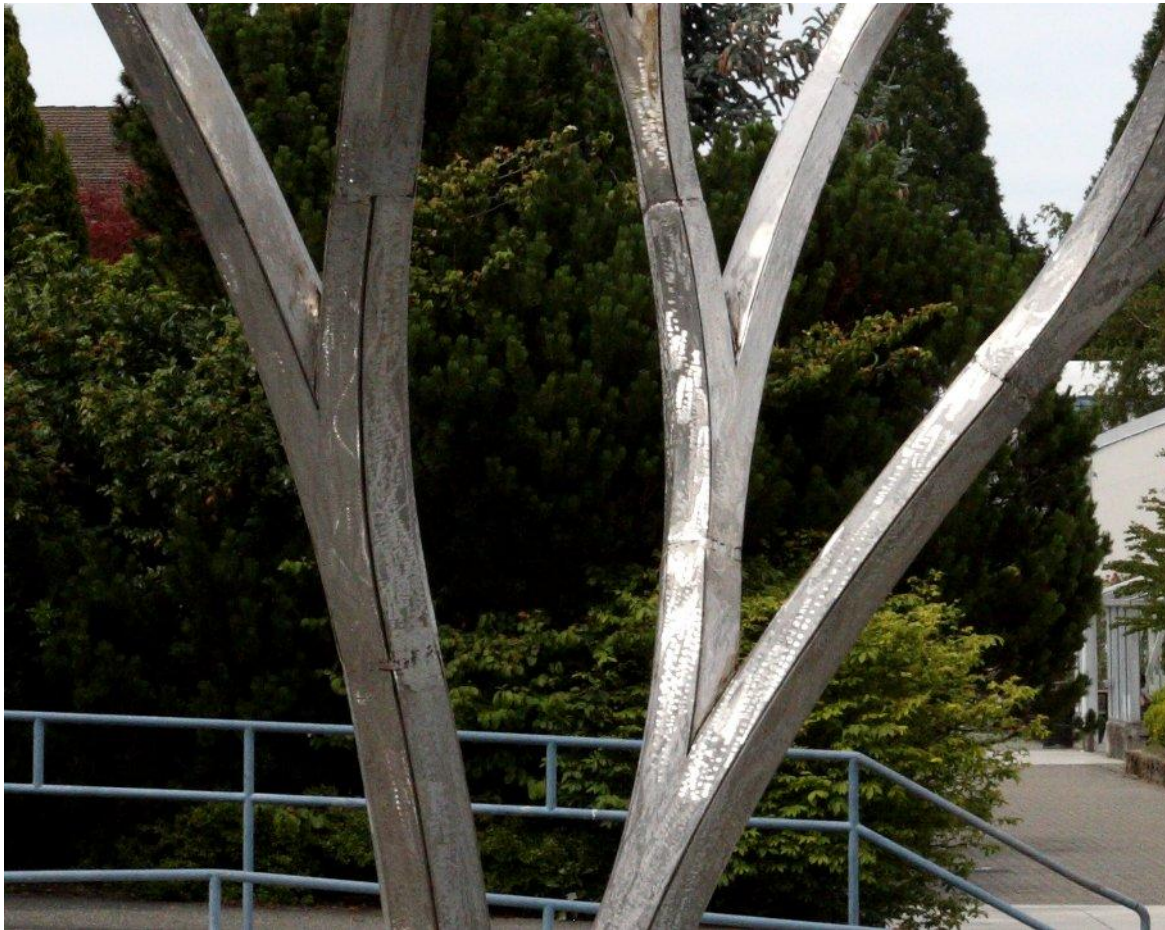
March 2013: CoA Planning and Development Review recommends accepting the donation (Department Review Committee headed by Humberto Rey, Great Streets Program Coordinator)

April 2013: Austin Arts Commission recommends accepting the donation

May 2013: AIPP gives staff briefing at Downtown Commission meeting

August/September 2013: Projected installation and accession into Art in Public Places collection

Review process per CoA Artwork Donation Policy, adopted by City Council March 2013
