APPLICATION FOR A CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATENESS C14H-1990-0012

Wooldridge Square 900 Guadalupe Street

PROPOSAL

Renovate the existing central gazebo, install benches and lighting, repair broken concrete pavement, and install a mobile food vendor area at the northwest corner of the park.

PROJECT SPECIFICATIONS

The applicant proposes to renovate the existing central gazebo in the park, replacing all deteriorated wood decking and stairs, and replacing it in kind. The applicant further proposes to install new metal benches and trash receptacles in the park and new lighting fixtures, to repair broken concrete pavement with in-kind materials, and to construct a paved area for a mobile food vendor at the northwest corner of the park.

STANDARDS FOR REVIEW

The Commission's Standards for Review of applications for Certificates of Appropriateness include:

- Do not destroy the distinguishing original qualities or character of a building, structure, or site and its environment. Avoid the removal or alteration of any historic material or distinctive architectural features.
- Recognize all buildings, structures, and sites as products of their own time. Do not construct alterations which have no historical basis and which seek to create an earlier appearance.
- Repair, rather than replace deteriorated architectural features wherever possible. In the event replacement is necessary, the new material should match the material being replaced in composition, design, color, texture, and other visual qualities. Base the repair or replacement of missing architectural features on accurate duplications of features, substantiated by historical, physical, or pictorial evidence rather than on conjectural designs or the availability of different architectural elements from other buildings or structures.
- Contemporary design for alterations and additions to existing properties are appropriate when such alterations and additions do not destroy significant historic, architectural, or cultural material and such design is compatible with the size, scale, color, material, and character of the property, neighborhood, or environment.

COMMITTEE RECOMMENDATIONS

The Committee recommended approval of all facets of the proposal except for the style of the lighting.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION

Approve the application as proposed with the understanding that the proposed lights are a temporary solution, to be able to open the park to the public as soon as possible, and will likely be replaced with more period-appropriate light fixtures upon the development of a master plan for Wooldridge Square in the near future.

- e. Cut sheet of park bench Plainwell Bench by Landscape Forms


Regarding the proposed park lighting; the cut sheet of the light standard proposed by PARD represents an interim solution. PARD anticipates developing a Master Plan for Wooldridge Square in the near future. The ability to utilize this particular fixture, in the interim, was based on its current wide spread use as a pedestrian vintage style light fixture. The fixture is widely used in adjacent pedestrian oriented settings within Austin's core such as the West University Neighborhood, Guadalupe Street and PARD's Renaissance Square. This fixture is intended to serve the existing park walkway temporarily as major master plan improvements will include recommendations to remove the existing non-compliant ADA walkway. The proposed light fixtures when removed, will then be able to be recycled\relocated at other locations as needed by PARD and Austin Energy. The development of the master plan will enable PARD to select a compatible long term fixture that will address lighting needs for a new and enhanced ADA compatible walkway system within the park and other site improvements.


Let me know if you need additional information regarding the light standard. Also, let me know if we definitely need to select another light fixture prior to HLC hearing on Monday May 20, 2013.




