This contract with Pipeline Video Inspection & Cleaning, Phoenix, AZ is for cleaning, televising and point repair of sanitary sewer collection system pipes ranging from 6" to 69", cleaning of flumes and vortex drop structures for the Austin Water Utility in areas outside of the downtown area. The cleaning process will remove sludge, roots, grease, grit solids and other debris from the wastewater pipes and adjacent manholes. The contract also includes televising the cleaned sewer mains and coding any defective conditions in the sewer mains on the GraniteXP software.

This contract was awarded through the competitive process in April 2012, in an amount not to exceed \$394,920 annually with two 12-month options. The Austin Water Utility had identified more lines that needed to be cleaned in the initial contract period and the first option period was exercised early to allow for the continuation of the services. With the exercising of the first option early the second option was deleted and a new solicitation is in process now, therefore, a 25% increase is being requested in the amount not to exceed \$98,730 which will allow for services to continue until a new contract is in place October 2013.
