Additional Backup Information

On July 19, 2012, Austin Transportation Department initiated discussions regarding the number of issues related to the operation of Charter Services. Most issues were attributed to the lack of parameters established within Subpart D (Charter Service) of the City Code. After a series of meetings with the identified stakeholders, including charter operators, limousine, airport shuttle, taxi drivers and franchisees, staff presents the following recommendations for Council consideration.

- A.) Expand on the description of "Charter Service" to include a pre-arrangement requirement of one half hour advance booking.
- B.) Prohibit charter services from displaying taxicab features.
- C.) Require Trip tickets.
- D.) Require fleet markings to be fleet-wide and unique to each individual fleet.
- E.) Inspection requirements for charter vehicles with a passenger capacity of 16 or more.
- F.) Amend the definition of "Prearranged Service" (City Code Section 13-2-1) which would impact all categories

with a prearranged requirement (limos, shuttles, tour and sightseeing) other than charters.
