

ORDINANCE NO.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CITY CODE SECTION 12-4-64(D) TO MODIFY THE SPEED LIMITS ON CERTAIN SEGMENTS OF AIRPORT BOULEVARD, TO ADD A 20 MILES PER HOUR SCHOOL ZONE ON A SEGMENT OF AIRPORT BOULEVARD FOR STUDENTS ATTENDING RIDGETOP ELEMENTARY SCHOOL, AND TO PROVIDE FOR EMERGENCY PASSAGE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:

PART 1. Section 12-4-64(D) (*Table of Speed Limits*) is amended to read:

Airport Boulevard from Lamar Boulevard (North) to 162 feet south of 53rd Street (East) [~~I.H. 35 (North) West Frontage Road~~]. (40 mph)

PART 2. Section 12-4-64(D) (*Table of Speed Limits*) is amended to add:

Airport Boulevard from 162 feet south of 53rd Street (East) to 55 feet south of 52nd Street (East) (35 mph)

Airport Boulevard from 258 feet south of 51st Street (East) to 185 feet south of 50th Street (35 mph)

Airport Boulevard from 55 feet south of 52nd Street (East) to 258 feet south of 51st Street (East) (20 mph school zone for students attending Ridgetop Elementary School)

Airport Boulevard from 185 feet south of 50th Street (East) to I.H.35 (North) West Frontage Road (40 mph)

PART 3. The amendments made in this ordinance are based on the results of a traffic engineering investigation, or “speed study,” attached as Exhibit “A”.

PART 4. The amendments made in this ordinance shall be incorporated in alphabetical order and the existing entries reordered accordingly.

PART 5. Council finds that school is in session, and the need for a school zone at this site constitutes an emergency. Because of this emergency, this ordinance takes effect

1 immediately on its passage for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
2 safety.
