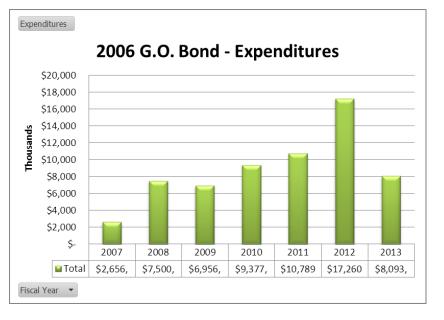




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Expenditures Summary and Remaining Projects

Bond Development Process

- April 2011 Initiate 2011 Capital Project Needs Assessment
 - Request for project proposal forms department-wide
 - Over 260 PARD projects submitted \$1.4B estimated needs
- May 2011 Prioritization of submittals based on Capital Planning Office (CPO) and Parks and Recreation Department (PARD) criteria
- June 2011 Projects submitted to CPO for review
- August 2011 Application of Council approved Guiding Principles
 - Imagine Austin Plan Priority Programs
 - PARD Long Range Plan, Business Plan and Master Plans
 - Reduced to 66 PARD projects \$130M estimated needs
- December 2011 Bond Election Advisory Task Force (BEATF)
 - Overview and project-specific presentations
 - PARD recommendations to inform program reductions
- June 2012 BEATF, City Manager and staff recommendations presented to City Council
- August 2012 City Council approves \$385M package
- November 2012 Voters approve Proposition 14

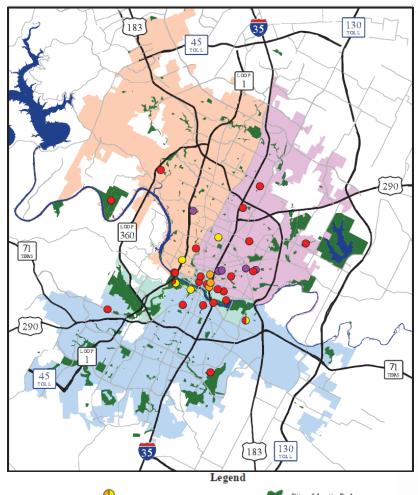




Geographic Analysis

- Geographic equity high priority during bond refinement process
- Analysis of geographic distribution throughout bond development process to inform BEATF decisions
- 2012 G.O. Bond breakdown according to PARD districts:

Northeast	\$6,190,000
Northwest	\$5,750,000
Central	\$32,050,000
South	\$16,480,000
City-wide	\$17,210,000







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Featured Projects: Montopolis Community Center

- Replace existing rec center with new 31,000+ sqft Community Center
- PARD/HHSD Joint-use Facility
 - \$11.78M under Prop 14 (PARD)
 - \$3.7M under Prop 17 (HHSD)
- Appropriation Schedule
 - □ FY13 \$1.6M
 - □ FY16 \$10.18M







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Featured Projects: Zilker Maintenance Barn

- Replace existing facility located in environmentally sensitive area
- Centralized location within Zilker Park; LEED design standards
- PARD Funding
 - □ \$2.75M under Prop 14
- Appropriation Schedule
 - □ FY15 \$500K
 - □ FY16 \$2.25M









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Featured Projects: Dove Springs District Park

- 2 projects: 4,000 sq ft rec center expansion & grounds improvements
- ADA improvements, community garden, playscape, restroom
- PARD Funding
 - □ \$750k under Prop 14 (grounds)
 - □ \$1.75M under Prop 14 (building)
- Appropriation Schedule
 - □ FY13 \$350K
 - □ FY14 \$700K
 - □ FY15 \$1.45M









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Featured Projects: Barton Springs Bathhouse

- Historical & structural evaluation; renovation focused primarily upon the historic entry rotunda
- PARD Funding
 - □ \$2M under Prop 14
- Appropriation Schedule
 - □ FY14 \$500K
 - □ FY16 \$1.5M
