In accordance with Section 43.125 of the Texas Local Government Code (LGC) the City must adopt by ordinance a regulatory plan for areas being annexed for limited purposes. City Council is scheduled to adopt an ordinance annexing Estancia annexation area on June 20, 2013. To comply with State law, Council must also adopt the Estancia regulatory plan.

The owners of the Estancia annexation area have requested limited purpose annexation in accordance with Section 43.127 LGC, waiving the requirement for conversion to full purpose status in three years. Future full purpose annexation will be considered in accordance with the "Final Development Agreement" associated with the proposed Public Improvement District and applicable provisions of State law and the City Charter.
