Authorize negotiation and execution of an amendment to the professional services agreements with the following three firms: HVJ ASSOCIATES, INC. (MBE /MB), Austin, TX; LOCKWOOD ANDREWS & NEWNAM, INC. Austin, TX; and HNTB CORPORATION, Austin TX; to provide professional engineering services for the Street Reconstruction Program Rotation List in the aggregate amount of \$1,525,000 in additional authorization, for a total not to exceed amount of \$18,285,000 for this rotation list to complete the following ACCELERATE AUSTIN projects: Rio Grande Street (HVJ Associates), Group 8 (Lockwood, Andrews & Newnam, Inc.), and Group 12 (HNTB Corporation). The additional authority will be allocated as follows: HVJ ASSOCIATES, INC. \$775,000; LOCKWOOD ANDREWS & NEWNAM, INC. \$550,000 and HNTB CORPORATION \$200,000.

February 1, 2007 - Council approved the Street Reconstruction Program Rotation List and authorized negotiation and execution of professional services agreements in an amount not to exceed \$12,500,000.

Additional Backup Information	
<p>The Street Reconstruction Program Rotation List 2006-2012 was established to provide engineering services to reconstruct or rehabilitate City roadways as specified in Proposition One of the 2006 Bond Referendum. On February 1, 2007, ten firms were selected with a total authorization in the amount of \$12,500,000; with \$1,500,000 in authorization for the top five ranking firms and \$1,000,000 for each of the five remaining firms. On July 23, 2009 an additional \$3,125,000 was authorized, with \$375,000 for the top five firms and \$250,000 for the five remaining firms. On March 24, 2011 an additional \$1,135,000 was authorized for seven of the firms; resulting in a total authorization of \$16,760,000. Approximately 99% of this amount has been contracted.</p> <p>Since the rotation list was first initiated, other improvements within the original project limits have been included such as water, waste-water, drainage, sidewalks, Great Streets amenities, and bike lanes to increase project delivery efficiency and reduce public inconvenience during the construction phase. In addition, two projects were initiated to take advantage of low construction costs in accordance with the ACCELERATE AUSTIN initiative. This amendment will allow the completion of three existing projects, Rio Grande Street from 24th Street to 29th Street, Group 8 (streets including and within the boundary of Stamford Lane, Vista Lane, Windsor Road and Woodmont Avenue), and Group 12 (Justin Lane).</p>
