Additional Backup Information

The EMS Department has been providing emergency medical services to Travis County for over thirty years. The most recent Interlocal Agreement, Amendment Four, with Travis County for EMS services was signed by the Deputy City Manager on January 17, 2013, for FY 2012-2013. This Amendment to the Agreement enhances the City's provision of EMS services to those areas of Travis County that are located outside the City of Austin's corporate limits.
