Authorize award and execution of a 24-month service agreement with ENTECH SALES AND SERVICE, INC., for security monitoring and as-needed repair for the Communiciations and Technology Management Department in an amount not to exceed \$53,820, with three 12-month extension options in an amount not to exceed \$26,910 per extension option, for a total contract amount not to exceed 134,550.

Amount and Source of Funding

Funding in the amount of \$6,727.50 is available in the Fiscal Year 2012-2013 Operating Budget of the Communications and Technology Management Department. Funding for the remaining contract period and the extension options is contingent upon available funding in future budgets.

Additional Backup Information

CTM has four sites with legacy security systems that require maintenance and support from a vendor authorized by the manufacturers. CTM did not consider acquiring the licenses required to provide direct support for these systems because the systems are old technology which will be replaced as part of the Enterprise Security Access System (ESAS) project. Alarm monitoring is part of the support of the systems. CTM Security on call personnel are contacted by the monitoring company when there is an alarm event.
