Authorize award and execution of two 36 month requirements service agreements with CASTLEVIEW PRODUCTIONS, or one of the other qualified offerors to RFP No. SDC0009 for videography services in an amount not to exceed \$116,025 with three 12-month extension options in an amount not to exceed \$38,675 per extension option for a total contract amount not to exceed \$232,050; and with HENNIG PRODUCTIONS, for photography services in an amount not to exceed \$30,345 with three 12-month extension options in an amount not to exceed \$10,115 per extension option for a total contract amount not to exceed \$60,690.

Amount and Source of Funding

Funding in the amount of \$13,040 is available in the Fiscal Year 2012-2013 Operating Budget of the Austin Resource Recovery Department. Funding for the remaining 4 months of the original contract period and for the extension options is contingent upon available funding in future budgets.

Additional Backup Information

Austin Resource Recovery's Strategic Initiatives Division is responsible for coordinating, managing, document and support the educational, promotional, marketing, and archival efforts of the Austin Resource Recovery Department (ARR). Part of this responsibility is to collect and maintain videos and/or photos to document and promote a myriad of events, activities, operations, equipment and employees. These services will provide ARR the ability to collect, maintain and utilize videography and photography services for education and promotional efforts.

This request allows for the development of an agreement with a qualified offerors that Council selects. If the City is unsuccessful in negotiating a satisfactory agreement with the selected offerors, negotiations will cease with that provider. Staff will return to Council so that Council may select another qualified offeror and authorize contract negotiations with that provider.

- a. Adequate competition.
- b. Four hundred twenty three notices were sent, including 31 MBE and 14 WBE firms. Ten proposals were received with no responses from MBEs and one response from WBEs.
