Authorize award and execution of a 36-month supply agreement with TECHLINE PIPE to provide inlet lids, manhole covers and rings, and grates for the Watershed Protection Department in the amount not to exceed \$199,394 with three 12-month extension options in an amount not to exceed \$66,465per extension option, for a total contract amount not to exceed \$398,789.

Amount and Source of Funding

Funding in the amount of \$11,077 is available in the Fiscal Year 2012-2013 Operating Budget of the Austin Watershed Protection Department. Funding for the remaining 32 months of the original contract period and extension options is contingent upon available funding in future budgets.

There is no unanticipated fiscal impact. A fiscal note is not required.

This contract will provide a reliable supply of inlet lids, covers, rings and grates for the Watershed Protection Department, Field Operations Division on an as needed basis. This supply agreement will insure that inlet lids, covers, rings and grates are readily available so that required repairs and maintenance can be made in a timely manner. The materials will be used for maintenance and construction activities.

Typical uses for the inlet covers and rings are as follows:

- a. Replacement of lost or stolen curb inlet lids,
- Replacement of existing deteriorated manhole rings and covers,
- c. For new storm sewer construction, and
- d. For ongoing maintenance.
