<p>This action will authorize the negotiation and execution of an Interlocal agreement with Texas State University – San Marcos to reimburse costs for law enforcement activity under the Texas Tobacco Enforcement Program for a total reimbursement not to exceed \$26,025. All law enforcement activity under this agreement will target Austin tobacco retailers and the potential for and/or suspected sale of tobacco products to minor age consumers. Activity will include controlled buys and stings for the time period of September 1, 2013 – August 31, 2014.</p>				
<p>This is the second year APD will receive a contract for tobacco enforcement from Texas State University. Year 1 concludes this August with an anticipated 350 controlled buy/stings and follow ups at retail locations citywide.</p>
