Approve a resolution authorizing the application for and acceptance of \$16,282 in grant funding from the State of Texas, Governor's Office, Criminal Justice Division to implement the Austin Police Department Juvenile Justice Project. Related to Item # 42.

## Amount and Source of Funding

Funding in the amount of \$16,282 is available from the State of Texas, Criminal Justice Division, Juvenile Accountability Incentive Programs for the project period of September 1, 2013 – August 31, 2014. A match of 10% of total project costs (\$1,809) is required. This requirement will be met using the salary of an existing Certified Peace Officer.

## Additional Backup Information

This action will provide the required resolution needed by the Criminal Justice Division to complete the award process related to \$16,282 in grant funding. The project period is September 1, 2013 – August 31, 2014.

State grant funding will cover costs for training for law enforcement personnel who directly interact with youths involved, or at high-risk for involvement, in the juvenile justice system.

The grantor requires a resolution approved by council that includes items one through four below.

1. Authorization by your governing body for the submission of the application to CJD that clearly identifies the name of the project for which funding is requested;
2. A commitment to provide all applicable matching funds;
3. A designation of the name and/or title of an authorized official who is given the authority to apply for, accept, reject, alter, or terminate a grant (Note: If a name is provided, you must update CJD should the official change during the grant period.); and
4. A written assurance that, in the event of loss or misuse of grant funds, the governing body will return all funds to CJD.
