Authorize award and execution of a 36-month requirements service contract with LBS ENTERPRISES, LLC. dba, ALLSTATES COATINGS, CO. to provide airfield traffic paint for the Aviation Department, in an amount not to exceed \$360,000, with three 12-month extension options in an amount not to exceed \$120,000 per extension option, a total contract amount not to exceed \$720,000.

Amount and Source of Funding

Funding in the amount of \$20,000 is available in the Fiscal Year 2012-2013 Operating Budget of the Aviation Department. Funding for the remaining 34 months of the original contract period and extension options is contingent upon available funding in future budgets.

There is no unanticipated fiscal impact. A fiscal note is not required.

This contract will provide approximately 10,250 gallons of traffic paint for use on Austin-Bergstrom International Airport's (ABIA) runways, taxiways, aprons, public streets, parking lots, and walkways and will be purchased on an as-needed basis. The airfield markings, including runways, taxiways, ramp markings and service roads, are repainted year round with frequencies ranging from every six weeks to annually.

ABIA is a Federal Aviation Regulation Part 139 Certificated airport, and is subject to the requirements and minimum standards set forth by the Federal Aviation Association. Among such standards are airfield markings to increase airfield safety and enhance runway and taxiway visibility to those that need them: pilots and others who operate on the airfield surfaces.
