PROJECT SUMMARY

In the fall of 2009, the City of Austin Art in Public Places (AIPP) program of the Cultural Arts Division, Economic Growth & Redevelopment Services Office (EGRSO) sought to commission an artist/design professional to program a lighting display utilizing LED equipment proposed to be installed as part of the I-35 Makeover Project. The artwork is intended to enhance the design of the improvements already installed by the City of Austin. AIPP staff assembled a short list of 15 qualified artists from the Artist Registry. The AIPP Panel then reviewed the applications and selected one artist and one alternate.

The I-35 Makeover Project is now complete and involved safety and infrastructure improvements to the two blocks beneath IH-35, where it passes over 6th, 7th and 8th Streets on the edge of downtown Austin. In addition to parking lot improvements, the design consists of fourteen curved and tapered galvanized steel poles supported under the freeway deck, with sixteen 2ft-long, programmable, LED color light fixtures attached at intervals along the undersides.

The total budget for artwork for this project is \$65,000. The scope of work has been revised to include collaboration with the Downtown Wayfinding Project and additional interactive elements for the LED lighting system.
