**ANALYSIS / ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:** The Austin Fire Department (AFD) has been awarded a Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) Assistance to Firefighters Grant to assist the fire department with a comprehensive home safety campaign.

This grant funding will allow AFD to accomplish the following:

- Purchase a "safety house" trailer and implement prevention demonstrations at community events.
- Coordinate smoke alarm and home safety inspection canvasing activities distributing grant-funded smoke alarms.
- Organize fire prevention activities for people with disabilities, senior citizens, and multi-cultural families.
- Create prevention publications for vulnerable populations.

The above activities will be supported by purchasing 1,000 smoke alarms, printed material and related contracts to translate media and technology related items, 12 iPads with related software and a model home safety trailer.
