Additional Backup Information

In order to modify or alter the existing speed limit of a street, Texas laws require that a traffic engineering investigation be performed. An investigation of Brodie Lane was conducted by the Traffic Engineering Division of the Austin Transportation Department in accordance with the procedures specified in the <u>Texas Procedures for Establishing Speed Zones, 2006</u>. The Traffic Engineering Division recommends adding the following amendment to City Code Section 12-4-64 (D) Table of Speed Limits:

Delete: Brodie Lane from Slaughter Lane (West) to 300 feet south of Aspen Creek Parkway. (45 MPH)

Add: Brodie Lane from Slaughter Lane (West) to 480 feet south of Aspen Creek Parkway. (40 MPH)
