ORDINANCE NO.

AN ORDINANCE LEVYING MUNICIPAL PROPERTY (AD VALOREM) TAXES FOR THE CITY OF AUSTIN, TEXAS, FOR FISCAL YEAR 2013-2014.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:

PART 1. The City Council levies, approves, and orders to be assessed and collected for the Fiscal Year 2013-2014, and for each subsequent calendar year until otherwise ordained, on all property in the limits of the City of Austin that is not exempt from taxation, a property (ad valorem) tax at the rate of \qquad per \$100 of taxable value. The tax rate consists of two components each of which are separately approved by Council: \qquad per \$100 of taxable value, the rate that, if applied to the total taxable value, will impose the total amount published under Section 26.04(e)(3)(C) of the Property Tax Code, less any amount of additional sales and use tax revenue that will be used to pay debt service; and \qquad per \$100 of taxable value, the rate that, if applied to the total taxable of the total taxable value, will impose the amount of taxable value, the rate that, if applied to the total taxable of per \$100 of taxable value, per \$100 of taxable value, the rate that will be used to pay debt service; and \qquad per \$100 of taxable value, the rate that, if applied to the total taxable value, will impose the amount of taxes needed to fund maintenance and operation expenditures of the City for the coming year.

PART 2. The Council adopts the following property tax exemptions as further described in Attachments "A" and "B-1" and "B-2":

Council finds that the owners of the properties identified in Attachment B-1 have provided the City with documentation that their properties are designated as Recorded Texas Historic Landmarks or state recorded archeological landmarks in accordance with Texas Tax Code 11.24(1).

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Council finds that the owners of the properties identified in Attachment B- 2 have provided the City with documentation that the properties are designated as a historically or archeologically significant site in need of tax relief to encourage their preservation pursuant 11-1-21 of the City Code as required by Texas Tax Code 11.24(2).
