## Item 47: Eliminate General Fund Contribution to Economic Development Department, \$1,280,445

## Information to Consider:

The proposed budget for the Economic Development Department in FY 13-14 is \$41.6 million. That amount represents:

- \$30.2 million in funds with use restrictions including grant commitments and Hotel Occupancy Tax appropriations,
- \$1.5 million in funding for Community Economic Development Programs,
- \$1.5 million in Workforce Development Programs, and
- \$8.3 million for department operations and programming.

## Impact:

Given the use restrictions on the majority of EDD funding, the proposed cut of \$1,280,445 would have to come from the three areas reflected in the table below.
