Downtown Bike Share Stations
Congress Avenue and Sixth Street Historic Districts

PROPOSAL

Install bike share stations. The applicant will present the proposed locations at the meeting.

PROJECT SPECIFICATIONS

The applicant proposes to install bike share stations to implement the City's new bike share program downtown. The bike share stations will be bolted into the pavement, and will consist of single- or double-side stations, depending on the number of share bikes for the location. The stations are metal, with bike docks, kiosks, and where possible, a solar panel. They are approximately 16 feet long, and have a width of 9'-8", including a 4-foot backup zone.



STANDARDS FOR REVIEW

None - this proposal is similar to that for existing bike racks.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION

Approve the application if the proposed locations are not directly on Congress Avenue, and are set back to behind the front of the Congress Avenue façade of a building.

SINGLE-SIDED STATION FOOTPRINT




DOUBLE-SIDED STATION FOOTPRINT

- Four docks fit on one base
- The kiosk is able to replace any dock
