Additional Backup Information

The EMS Department has been providing emergency medical services to Travis County for over thirty years. The most recent Interlocal Agreement, Amendment 5, with Travis County for EMS services was signed by the City on May, 2013, for FY 2012-2013. The last renewal term will expire on September 30, 2013.

This Agreement addresses the City's provision of EMS services to those areas of Travis County that is located outside the City of Austin's corporate limits. The monthly EMS fee to be paid to the City. Travis County reimburses the City for these services through a flat monthly rate that corresponds to the annual operating budget for EMS. This agreement also addresses City's dispatch support of the County's STAR Flight air ambulance program.

The agreement authorizes up to two additional 12-month renewal terms.
