This Contract is for the purchase of a Computer-Aided Dispatch and Record Management System with Integrated Mobile and Geographic Systems (CAD/RMS/GIS/MAS) and will be used for dispatching security personnel, tracking calls, and report records management of security activities at the Austin Convention Center Department (ACCD).

In 2010, an assessment of ACCD's Security and Safety Division was performed which focused on the then-current practices that supported the security and safety of all hosted events, employees, and physical facilities. As a result of the assessment, ACCD made changes to its practices and procedures in the areas of security, safety, access control and all other aspects of emergency management. Additionally, the assessment identified the need for an integrated software system to support the Security Control Center with employee and public safety, emergency management, Police/Fire/EMS notification and response, real-time on-scene information sharing, and incident tracking and reporting.

The implementation of this system will bring much needed support for approximately 300 meetings, conferences, conventions, and approximately 1,000,000 annual visitors to the Austin Convention Center, the Palmer Events Center, the African American heritage Center, and the three associated major ACCD Parking Facilities.

This scaled system will support ACCD and may be shared with other City of Austin departments with similar requirements.
