

RESOLUTION NO.

WHEREAS, the City Council was requested to conduct a public hearing to consider the use of land for the permanent use and temporary working space use for construction, use, maintenance, repair, and replacement of a wastewater line for the Austin Water Utility Wastewater Line Relay and Spot Repair Services through dedicated parkland known as the Hartford Strip (the “Proposed Use”); and

WHEREAS, the land being used for the Proposed Use (the “Affected Land”) is generally located on the Hartford Strip parkland, located between Mopac Expressway and 2506 Hartford Road to 2614 Jefferson Street; and

WHEREAS, notice of the public hearing to be held on September 26, 2013 was given for three consecutive weeks on September 1, 8, and 15, 2013 in a newspaper of general circulation; and

WHEREAS, such public hearing was held September 26, 2013, by the City Council to consider the use of Affected Land for the Proposed Use;
NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:

Having taken into account clearly enunciated local preferences, the City Council finds that there is no feasible and prudent alternative to the use of the Affected Land for the Proposed Use and that all reasonable planning has been done to minimize harm to the Affected Land from the Proposed Use. The use of the Affected Land for the Proposed Use is approved.

The City Manager is authorized to take such measures as may be necessary, favorable, or required to effectuate the purpose and intent of this resolution.
