Additional Backup Information

Under the Gas Utilities Regulatory Act (Chapters 101 through 105 of the Texas Utilities Code) ("GURA"), the City has original jurisdiction over gas utility rates set for customers within its city limits. In July of this year, Atmos Energy Corporation, Mid-Tex Division, filed for an increase in system-wide rates, pursuant to a rate review mechanism, of approximately \$22.7 million. Austin is a member of the Atmos Texas Municipalities (ATM) coalition who hired rate experts to review the reasonableness of the request. After months of investigation by ATM's expert rate consultants and weeks of negotiation, ATM's counsel has proposed that the ATM municipalities agree to a reduced rate increase of \$16.6 million.

The City Charter requires that City Council must conduct a public hearing prior to approving a franchisee's rate increase.
