PART 17.

§ 25-8-92 CRITICAL WATER QUALITY ZONES ESTABLISHED.

(A) <u>In the water supply rural watersheds, water supply suburban watersheds, and</u> <u>Barton Springs zone, a [A] critical water quality zone is established along each waterway</u> classified under Section 25-8-91 (*Waterway Classifications*).

(2) Notwithstanding the provisions of Subsections (A) (1) (a), (b), and (c), a critical water quality zone does not <u>apply to a previously modified</u> <u>drainage feature serving a public roadway right of way that does not</u> <u>possess any natural and traditional character and cannot reasonably be</u> <u>restored to a natural condition, as prescribed in the Environmental</u> <u>Criteria Manual [extend beyond the crest of a bluff].</u>

§ 30-5-92 CRITICAL WATER QUALITY ZONES ESTABLISHED.

- (A) In the water supply rural watersheds, water supply suburban watersheds, and <u>Barton Springs zone, a [A]</u> critical water quality zone is established along each waterway classified under Section 30-5-91 (Waterway Classifications).
 - (2) [(3)] Notwithstanding the provisions of Subsections (A) (1)[(2)](a), (b), and (c), a critical water quality zone does not apply to a previously modified drainage feature serving a public roadway right of way that does not possess any natural and traditional character and cannot reasonably be restored to a natural condition, as prescribed in the Environmental Criteria Manual [extend beyond the crest of a bluff].
