#### Additional Backup Information

The Avaña-Spillar annexation area (approximately 293 acres) is located in southwestern Travis County and northeastern Hays County approximately one and one quarter miles south of the intersection of State Highway 45 and Escarpment Blvd. This area is currently in the city's limited purpose jurisdiction and the extraterritorial jurisdiction and is adjacent to the city's full purpose jurisdiction on the northeast side. This area is undeveloped and includes the proposed Avaña Phase 2 and Avaña Phase 3 single family residential subdivisions (C8J-2012-0086 and C8J-2012-0114) that are currently in review and include a total of 260 single-family residential lots.
