SUBJECT: Approve an ordinance waiving certain fees and requirements under City Code Chapter 14-8 and authorize payment of certain costs for the Texas-Sized Pittie Pride event sponsored by Love-A-Bull which is to be held on Sunday, October 27, 2013 with a parade up Congress Avenue ending with a festival at Republic Square Park.

ANALYSIS / ADDITIONAL INFORMATION: The total amount of fees for this event are $\$ 1,656$. This item waives $\$ 687$ in fees, leaving $\$ 969$ in Austin Police Department fees that have not been waived.

As outlined in Resolution No. 021003-40, Council Member Martinez has agreed to apply $\$ 350$ to his fee waiver allocation budget, Council Member Morrison has agreed to apply $\$ 200$ to her fee waiver allocation budget and Mayor Pro Tem Cole has agreed to apply $\$ 137$ to her fee waiver allocation budget. Additionally, the $\$ 100$ Parks and Recreation Department refundable damage deposit is also being waived. Any fee requirements above the \$687 total are the responsibility of the applicant.

Waiving fees for this event results in unrealized revenue for the Transportation Fund, Austin Transportation Department; General Fund, Austin Police Department, Austin Fire and Parks and Recreation Departments. Although budgeted revenue for fees is based upon historical data and not necessarily upon specific events, the waiver of these fees reduces potential revenues that could be realized.
