The purpose of this land acquisition is to site the planned Austin Resource Recovery (ARR) North Service Facility on approximately 131 acres of land in the northeast sector of the City. In an effort to co-locate various city departments, this facility may also support services provided by Fleet Services (FSO), Parks and Recreation Department (PARD), and the Austin Transportation Department (ATD).

The approximate 131 acre site falls within the City of Austin master plan for a series of efforts proposed in the Strategic Facilities and Logistics Roadmap.

Planned utilization options for the site include Household Hazardous Waste Collection Center, Reuse and Recycling Drop-off Center, ARR fleet deployment, vehicle fueling and repair facilities, equipment storage, and administrative offices. A full proposal of site plans and construction details, including a financial proforma, will be presented to Council at a later date.

An independent third party appraisal was conducted on this property. The owners have agreed to accept the City of Austin's offer in the amount of \$4,500,000.
