Tourism.						
Founded in 1995, eBay Inc. is a global commerce and payments leader providing a robust platform where merchants						
of all sizes can compete and win. eBay Inc. is proposing a projected capital investment of \$8,486,323.00 by leasing 66,000 square feet of office space through a long-term lease in North Austin. The company plans to grow the eBay						
customer support function by committing to hire 400 new employees, as well as retain 500 current employees. The
