The Shoal Creek – Allandale Storm Drain Improvements project is complete and has mitigated localized flooding in the Allandale neighborhood bounded by Burnet Rd., Allandale Rd., MoPac, and White Horse Trail.

During project construction, determination was made that approximately 1900 linear feet of the existing 12" water main on Bull Creek Road had reached its maximum life expediency and required replacement. The design consultant contract was amended to enable design of the replacement water main for inclusion into the construction contract. During the period of design and construction of the waterline, the contractor was required to maintain a safe driving surface on the project roadways, installing additional quantities of cold mix asphalt over large areas of excavations for an extended period of time. This change order is necessary to pay the contractor for these additional quantities of cold mix asphalt.

The Law Department prepared a Health and Safety Affidavit that was executed by the Public Works Director in support of the issuance of this change order under the exception to the requirement of bidding, as provided by Section 252.022 of the Texas Local Government Code.

This project is located within zip code 78757 and is managed by the Public Works Department.
