Additional Backup Information

Certain language that was adopted by the City and Travis County in the spring of 2013 in the renewal and amendment to the existing interlocal agreement for the Summer Youth Employment Program specifically states that funding allocated is for the 2013 renewal term, which is the time period from September 1, 2013 through August 31, 2014. Thus, this language inadvertently prohibits the parties from utilizing allocated funds to pay for program activities that occurred before Sept. 1, 2013. However, when the parties agreed to renew the agreement, their intention was that allocated funds be available to pay for the services provided during the summer activities that predated September 1, 2013. The purpose of this amendment is to clarify that allocated funds may be utilized to pay for services provided prior to the beginning of the renewal term of September 1, 2013, and after the beginning of the renewal term, as needed.
