Authorize award and execution of a 36-month requirements supply contract with ADVANCED FILTRATION PRODUCTS, LLC, to provide air conditioning and heating equipment replacement filters for the Aviation Departments in an amount not to exceed \$38,544, with three 12-month extension options in an amount not to exceed \$12,848 per extension option, a total contract amount not to exceed \$77,088.

Amount and Source of Funding

Funding in the amount of \$9,636 is available in the Fiscal Year 2013-2014 Operating Budget of the Aviation Department. Funding for the remaining 27 months of the original contract period and extension options is contingent upon available funding in future budgets.
