

**RESOLUTION NO. \_\_\_\_\_**

**WHEREAS**, severe flooding occurred on October 30<sup>th</sup>, 2013, and continued through November 16<sup>th</sup>, 2013, causing a disaster in Central Texas counties including Travis County, which encompasses property in the Austin area; and

**WHEREAS**, on December 13, 2013, in accordance with the authority vested in him by Texas Government Code Sections 418.014 through 418.017, as a result of this severe flooding, Governor Rick Perry declared a state of disaster in Central Texas counties including Travis County; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Austin desires to request of the Travis Central Appraisal District that all the property damaged in the disaster be reappraised as is authorized by Texas Tax Code Section 23.02; **NOW THEREFORE**,

**BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:**

The City of Austin requests the Travis Central Appraisal District reappraise as soon as practicable all property with the City of Austin city limits that was damaged by the disaster declared by the Governor of the State of Texas.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED:**

Beginning on the date of the disaster and for the remainder of 2013, the City will apply its tax rate to the reappraised market value of the properties that are reappraised by the Travis Central Appraisal District.
