Additional Backup Information	

This project includes the installation of 3,958 linear feet of 8-inch diameter wastewater line in the following streets which were annexed in December 2009: Hidden Meadow Drive from US 183 to its terminus; Lois Lane from Caldwell Drive to its terminus; 778 feet from the terminus of Caldwell Drive to an existing manhole within the right of way; and 300 linear feet in Aldridge Drive to Brown Lane.

This project is approximately 80% complete and the initial contingency and administrative authority has been used to mitigate unexpected voids that were encountered during construction. These unexpected conditions have impacted the project schedule and budget. There is a high potential for the discovery of additional karst features due to the terrain of the remaining work areas. Therefore, an additional 10% contingency is requested to allow for the expeditious processing of future change orders.

This item has been reviewed by the City's Change Control Committee.
