Additional Backup Information

In June 2013, Texas state law was amended to allow breweries to sell beer that is produced on-site for on-site consumption. On October 3, 2013, the City Council directed the City Manager to initiate an amendment of Title 25 to allow breweries in Austin to sell alcoholic beverages produced on-site for on-site consumption. The sale of these alcoholic beverages for on-site consumption would be permitted if the brewery is at least 540 ft. from any single-family residential use, and conditional for a brewery within 540 ft. of any single-family use.
