## Additional Backup Information

On November 21, 2013, the City Council directed the City Manager, in Resolution No. 20131121-053, to work on a code amendment examining a possible reduction in occupancy for unrelated individuals. This council resolution was in response to concerns about over-occupancy in single-family zoned neighborhoods, where "stealth dorms" have caused code compliance issues. Specifically, the council resolution initiates a code amendment related to dwelling unit occupancy that will set the maximum number of unrelated adults who may reside in structures allowed on single-family zoned property at four. The resolution also provides for alternative recommendations from the Planning Commission related to maximum occupancy and applicability.
