
### Great Lawn Tree Damage


- 38" pecan along Barton Springs Road
- Trenched on 3 sides
  - -6' to west
  - -12' to south
  - 22' to north
- Seven 2-3" roots severed, many 1-2" roots
- Damage done by PARD central maintenance staff











# 38" Pecan, Next Steps


- Damaged roots cleanly cut by an arborists and trenches backfilled (2-14-14), inspected by Forestry staff
- Central Parks Maintenance Staff submitted postdamage application for a Tree Ordinance Review by City Arborists Office
- Remediation and mitigation options under discussion
- Training program for parks maintenance staff about root physiology and root impacts

## **Barton Springs Pool Tree Court**

- No other project has received the level of arborist inclusion and oversight as this project
- Full-time arborist hired to be on-site during all phases of project, weekly meetings, treefocused project phasing
- While arborist not present, heavy equipment graded entire tree court area, causing compaction and torn roots during the week of 2-10-14
