Additional Backup Information

This ordinance repeals the specialized pay ordinance adopted by Council on September 26, 2002, and establishes specialized functions, certifications and assignments; requirements and criteria for additional pay; and pay rates for specialized pay within the Austin Fire Department. Revisions are requested so that the ordinance reflects current practices.

The Hazardous Materials Team and the Search and Rescue Team described in Part 1: Specialized Functions, Certifications and Assignments, Section F, and Part 2: Requirements and Criteria for Additional Pay, Section F, have been combined and are now defined as "Special Operations Pay". The Special Operations Battalion Chief pay, and related sections defining the required training and certifications, has been eliminated. In Part 3: Additional Pay, Section F, "Special Operations Teams Pay" was revised to "Special Operations Pay" and "Special Operations Battalion Pay" was deleted. The rate for Special Operations Pay (\$150) has not changed.
