ORDINANCE NO.

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING SPECIALIZED FUNCTIONS, CERTIFICATIONS AND ASSIGNMENTS FOR FIREFIGHTERS; AUTHORIZING ADDITIONAL PAY; AND REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 020926-13.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:

PART 1. SPECIALIZED FUNCTIONS, CERTIFICATIONS AND ASSIGNMENTS

In accordance with Texas Local Government Code Chapter 143, and in addition to base pay for firefighters approved by Council under separate ordinance, the City Council establishes the following specialized functions, certifications, and assignments:

- (A) Firefighter Certification;
 - (1) Intermediate Firefighter Certification
 - (2) Advanced Firefighter Certification
 - (3) Master Firefighter Certification
- (B) Education Incentive;
- (C) Airport Fire and Rescue;
- (D) Bilingual Translation;
- (E) Staff Schedule;
- (F) Special Operations;

PART 2. REQUIREMENTS AND CRITERIA FOR ADDITIONAL PAY

A firefighter who meets the criteria and complies with the requirements established by this part shall receive additional pay.

- (A) To receive Firefighter Certification Pay a firefighter must:
 - (1) obtain the applicable certification from the Texas Commission on Fire Protection; and
 - (2) provide proof of certification to the Fire Department.
