This contract is for the purchase of 800,000 lbs. annually of liquid ammonium sulfate for use at the Austin Water Utility's Water Treatment Plant #4 which is anticipated to come online Summer 2014. The product will be delivered on an as needed basis and stored in two tanks located at the facility.

Liquid Ammonium Sulfate (LAS) is combined with Chlorine to form chloramines which is the disinfectant used in the distribution system. This is a different chemical than that used at the other water plants to form chloramines.
