



- 1.2 <u>Order of Precedence</u>. Any inconsistency or conflict in the Contract documents shall be resolved by giving precedence in the following order:
 - 1.2.1 This Contract
 - 1.2.2 The City's Solicitation as referenced in Section 1.1.2, including all documents incorporated by reference
 - 1.2.3 The Contractor's Offer as referenced in Section 1.1.3, including subsequent clarifications
- 1.3 **Term of Contract.** The Contract will be in effect for an initial term of thirty-six (36) months and may be extended thereafter for up to three (3) twelve (12) month extension option(s), subject to the approval of the Contractor and the City Purchasing Officer or his designee. (b) When any device or protection is used, including, but not limited to, space protection, which may be affected by turbulence of air, occupied airspace change or other disturbance, forced air heaters, air conditioners, horns, bells, animals and any other source of air turbulence or movement which may interfere with the effectiveness of the System during closed periods while the alarm

system is on, City shall notify Contractor. (c) City shall notify Contractor regarding any remodeling or other changes to the protected premises that may affect operation of the System. (d) City shall cooperate with Contractor in the installation, operation, and maintenance of the system and agrees to follow all instructions and procedures which may be prescribed for the operation of the System, the rendering of services and the provision of security for the premises. (e) City shall pay all charges made by any telephone company or other utility for installation, leasing, and service charges of telephone lines connecting City's premises to Contractor. City acknowledges that alarm signals from City's premises to Contractor are transmitted over City's telephone service and that in the event the telephone service is out of order, disconnected, placed on "vacation," or otherwise interrupted, signals from City's alarm system will not be received by Contractor during any such interruption in telephone service and the interruption will not be known to Contractor. City agrees that in the event the equipment or system continuously transmits signals reasonably determined by Contractor to be false and/or excessive in number, City shall be subject to the additional costs and fees incurred by Contractor in receiving and/or responding to the excessive signal.

- 1.5.6.5 Authorized Personnel & Emergency Information. City agrees to furnish forthwith a written list of the names, addresses and telephone numbers of all persons authorized to enter or remain on City's premises and/or that should be notified in the event of an alarm. City agrees to provide all changes, revisions and modifications to the above to Contractor in writing in a timely manner. City shall furnish to Contractor certain emergency information and shall keep it current by providing Contractor with any changes in writing, providing the required identifying information in a timely manner.
- 1.5.6.6 Taxes, Fees, Fines, Licenses, and Permits. (a)City agrees to pay all use tax, property tax, utility tax and other taxes required in connection with the equipment and services listed, including telephone company line charges, if any. Contractor shall have the right, at any time, to pass along to City any increases in the monthly charges which hereafter may be imposed on Contractor by utility or government agencies relating to the service(s) provided under the terms of this Agreement, and City hereby agrees to pay the same. (b) City agrees to assume all responsibility for any false alarms or signals given by the protective equipment. (c) City shall comply with all laws and regulations relating to the equipment and its use and shall promptly pay when due all use, property, excise and other taxes and all license and registration fees now or hereafter imposed by any government body or agency upon the equipment or its use. If City fails to maintain any required licenses or permits, Contractor shall not be responsible for performing the services and may terminate the services with notice to City.
- 1.5.6.7 Outside Charges. City understands and accepts that Contractor specifically denies any responsibility for charges associated with the notification or dispatching of anyone, including, but not limited to, fire department, police department, paramedics, doctors, or any other emergency personnel, and if there are any charges incurred as a result of said notification or dispatch, said charges shall be the responsibility of City, whether requested or not and whether such entities were correctly or incorrectly notified by Contractor, its agents, or subcontractors.
- Default/Termination. In the event City fails to pay any amount, City abuses the equipment or the use of the monitoring facility. City fails to comply with any of the terms and conditions hereof, City makes an assignment for the benefit of creditors, an order for relief is entered against City under any chapter of the National Bankruptcy Code, as amended, a receiver or trustee is appointed for all, or substantially all, the assets of City, or there is a dissolution or termination of existence of City, or if City is in default under this Agreement and such default continues for ten (10) days after Contractor gives City written notice of such default, in addition to any other remedies provided by law, Contractor may pursue any one or more of the following remedies, which are cumulative and nonexclusive: (a) Terminate all services subscribed for hereunder by giving ten (10) days written notice to City, without terminating this Agreement, and recover all amounts due to Contractor; (b) Take possession of all Contractor owned equipment wherever situated and for such purpose at a reasonable time mutually agreed to by both parties; (c) By notice to City, declare immediately due and payable all moneys to be paid by City during the Primary Term or, if the Primary Term has then expired, declare immediately due and payable all moneys to be paid during any Renewal Term then in effect, and City shall thereupon be obligated to pay such moneys to Contractor immediately. City shall in any event remain fully liable for reasonable damages as provided by law and for all costs and expenses incurred by Contractor on account of such default including all court costs and reasonable attorneys' fees. The waiver by Contractor of a breach of any obligation of City shall not be deemed a waiver of such obligation or any subsequent breach of the same or any other obligation. The subsequent acceptance of payment hereunder by Contractor shall not be deemed a waiver of any prior existing breach, regardless of Contractor's knowledge of such prior existing breach at the time of acceptance of such payments.

This Contract (including any Exhibits) constitutes the entire agreement of the parties regarding the subject matter of this Contract and supersedes all prior and contemporaneous agreements and understandings, whether written or oral, relating to such subject matter. This Contract may be altered, amended, or modified only by a written instrument signed by the duly authorized representatives of both parties.

Smoke Detector Cleaning - Either 50% or 100% of Devices Cleaned Annually SMOKE DETECTOR CLEANING:

Accessible smoke detection devices will be cleaned using manufacturer's recommended procedures. Devices may be dismantled to expose the smoke chamber (where applicable.) NOTE: Certain types of analog smoke sensors will be cleaned as needed per panel readings. Cleaning of Smoke detectors annually will decrease troubles and alarms due to dirty smoke detector heads.

Smoke Detector Sensitivity Testing - Either 50% or 100% of Devices Annually Tested SENSITIVITY TESTING FOR CONVENTIONAL SMOKE DETECTORS:

Smoke detector sensitivity testing will be performed on smoke detectors. Testing will be performed using UL/ULC approved sensitivity testing equipment. Devices performing outside the listed sensitivity range will be re-cleaned and re-tested, and, if necessary, noted and recommended for replacement. NOTE: Certain types of analog smoke sensors automatically satisfy this testing requirement through sensitivity reports printed from the fire alarm panel.

Excludes duct smoke detectors. Sensitivity testing of Smoke Detectors will help ensure that the detectors will detect smoke in the event of a fire. Age, dirt, and dust often decrease the sensitivity of detectors over time.

SENSITIVITY TESTING FOR FIRE ALARM AND DETECTION SYSTEMS:

To ensure accuracy, and in accordance with NFPA guidelines, sensitivity testing is required on smoke detectors at a minimum rate of 50% annually.

Testing will be performed using only UL approved sensitivity testing equipment. Devices performing outside the listed sensitivity range will be re-cleaned and re-tested, and if necessary, noted and recommended for replacement. NOTE: Certain types of analog smoke sensors will automatically satisfy this requirement electronically.

24/7 Full Service Fire Alarm Coverage

24-hour/7-day Service (Provided 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, including holidays). This service includes parts and labor, travel, and mileage charges for repairs associated with normal wear and tear. Emergency service will be provided within 2 hours of notification unless a different response time has been outlined in the agreement. Acts of God, Vandalism, Faulty Wiring, and Ground Faults are not covered repairs.

Monday-Friday/8am-5pm Full Service Fire Alarm Coverage

This service includes parts and labor, travel, and mileage charges for repairs associated with normal wear and tear during business hours. Acts of God, Vandalism, Faulty Wiring, and Ground Faults are not covered repairs.

24/7 Labor Only Fire Alarm Service Coverage

24-hour/7-day Service (Provided 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, including holidays). This service includes labor, travel, and mileage charges for repairs associated with normal wear and tear. Emergency service will be provided within 2 hours of notification unless a different response time has been outlined in the agreement. Acts of God, Vandalism, Faulty Wiring, and Ground Faults are not covered repairs.

Monday-Friday/8am-5pm Labor Only Fire Alarm Service Coverage

This service includes labor, travel, and mileage charges for repairs associated with normal wear and tear during normal business hours. Acts of God, Vandalism, Faulty Wiring, and Ground Faults are not covered repairs.

Note: Various Non-Simplex Fire Alarm Panels may require a subcontractor for programming, but all other services would be provided by SimplexGrinnell.

PARTS AND COMPONENT REPLACEMENT:

PANEL AND PERIPHERAL COMPONENT REPLACEMENT FOR LISTED ELECTRONIC SYSTEMS:

Additionally, these Special Provisions cover component replacement on the central processing unit, to include reprogramming of system due to failure, replacement of circuit boards, and all components in the control panels, annunciator panels, transponders, printers, keyboards monitors, and peripheral devices (smoke detectors, pull stations, audible/ visible units, door contacts, etc.) associated with system. Panel batteries are included.

Exclusions: Repair or replacement of faulty wiring is not covered, repair or replacement of non-maintainable parts of the Covered System(s) is not covered, including, but not limited to, unit cabinets, insulating material, electrical wiring, structural supports, and all other non-moving parts, is not included.

EMERGENCY SERVICE CALL AND LABOR:

This provision covers labor to troubleshoot and diagnose system problems, and the labor to replace failed devices.

Any repairs not covered would be subject to normal contract service rates.

SRINKLER SYSTEM SERVICE COVERAGE:

24/7 Full Sprinkler System Coverage

24-hour/7-day Service (Provided 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, including holidays). This service includes specified parts and labor, travel, and mileage charges for associated Sprinkler repairs. Emergency service will be provided within 2 hours of notification unless a different response time has been outlined in the agreement. Please see exclusions.

24/7 Labor Only Sprinkler System Coverage

24-hour/7-day Service (Provided 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, including holidays). This service includes labor, travel, and mileage charges for associated Sprinkler repairs. Emergency service will be provided within 2 hours of notification unless a different response time has been outlined in the agreement. Please see exclusions.

Monday-Friday/8am-5pm Full Sprinkler Service Coverage

This service includes specified parts and labor, travel, and mileage charges for associated Sprinkler repairs during normal business hours. Please see exclusions.

Monday-Friday/8am-5pm Labor Only Sprinkler Service Coverage

This service includes labor, travel, and mileage charges for associated Sprinkler repairs during normal business hours. Please see exclusions.

PARTS/COMPONENT REPLACEMENT FOR LISTED SPRINKLER MECHANICAL SYSTEMS: Replacement of all moving parts to include sprinkler heads, clappers, gaskets, hand hole cover hardware and gaskets, gauges, main drain valves, all valves associated with trim, hose valves, water motor gongs, air compressors, jockey pumps, air maintenance devices etc. associated with system. Exclusions: Replacement of faulty or leaking piping, fittings, fire pumps, and electrical control equipment; Internal Pipe Obstruction and Corrosion (including but not limited to micro-bacterially induced corrosion ("MIC"); Flushing internal pipe corrosion and obstruction.

GAS SUPPRESSION SYSTEM SERVICE COVERAGE:

24/7 Full Gas System Coverage (Kitchen Hoods / Gas Suppression Systems)

24-hour/7-day Service (Provided 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, including holidays). This service includes specified parts and labor, travel, and mileage charges for associated repairs. Emergency service will be provided within 24 hours of notification unless a different response time has been outlined in the agreement. Please see exclusions.

Monday-Friday/8am-5pm Suppression System Coverage (Kitchen Hoods, Gas Suppression) Monday-Friday/8am-5pm Service for Suppression System. This service includes specified parts, labor, travel, and mileage charges for associated repairs during normal business hours. Please see exclusions. Chemical Agent for recharging system is not included.

Explanation of Coverage for Kitchen Hoods and Gas Suppression Systems:

Kitchen Hood: Parts and labor for Links and the cable for the kitchen hood pull station are covered.

Sapphire System: Parts and Labor for the control panel and peripheral devices are covered. Control modules and relays for solenoids are covered. Panel Batteries are included.

Chemical Agent for recharging chemical suppression systems is <u>not</u>included.

General Exclusions:

This Agreement expressly excludes, without limitation, provision of fire watches; clearing of ice blockage; draining of improperly pitched piping; recharging of chemical suppression systems; reloading of, upgrading, and maintaining computer software; making repairs or replacements necessitated by reason of negligence or misuse of components or equipment or changes to Customer's premises, faulty wiring, vandalism, corrosion (including but not limited to micro-bacterially induced corrosion ("MIC"), power failure, current fluctuation, failure due to non-Company installation, lightning, electrical storm, or other severe weather, water, accident, fire, acts of God or any other

cause external to the Covered System(s). This Agreement does not cover and specifically excludes system upgrades and the replacement of obsolete systems, equipment, components or parts. All such services may be provided by Company at Company's sole discretion at an additional charge.
